

# Emerald Show Society

## Rubbish/Clean up

Collection and removal of ground rubbish and rubbish bin content to skip bins provided over the duration and after the show.

### **Monday 2nd June 2025** Afternoon:

- Empty full wheelie bins by removing bags and disposing into provided skips in located in the rodeo arena
- Pick up any rubbish that is on the grounds - This will mostly be in the camping and guild areas

### **Tuesday 3rd June 2025** Morning early:

- Pick up any rubbish that is on the grounds and place into bins
- Empty any full wheelie bins into the provided skip bins and replace bags
- Due to the function held on Monday night in the area in front of show office, a focus on this area will be required prior to the event opening to patrons at 8am. Another focus would be around the camping areas.

### Early - mid Afternoon:

- A walk through prior to the busy period of 4pm till 8:30pm is recommend and can prevent large volumes of rubbish needed to be picked up on Wednesday morning.
- Pick up any rubbish that is on the grounds and place into bins
- Empty any full wheelie bins into the provided skip bins and replace bags

### **Wednesday 4th June 2025** Morning early (Roughly 5am):

- An early start is needed as there is no vehicle movement permitted inside the public access area of the show after 8am.
- Line up all wheelie bins in the main area (side show alley and around the main part of the arena) next to main road through the showgrounds 1m apart for JJ's waste to empty around 7am. Only bin with EMD SHOW or JJ's Waste (Roughly 100 in total) to be lined up.
- Any wheelie bins outside of the main area to be emptied into the provided skips
- Any extra rubbish that won't fit into the wheelie bins to be disposed of into the skips.
- Focus areas would include the bar area and side show alley as these are high traffic areas on Tuesday night and then again on Wednesday there for they will need to be clean and tidy for patrons.

### Afternoon:

- Pick up any rubbish that is on the grounds and place into bins
- Line up main area wheelie bins (Roughly 100) next to main road through the showgrounds 1m apart for JJ's Waste to empty between 7-9am Thursday Morning.

## **Thursday 5th June 2025 - Afternoon**

- Rubbish to be picked up and placed into the bins - this should be a minor job as most people will have left the camping area however some stay until the weekend.

## **Sunday 9th June 2025 - Anytime**

- Final rubbish clean up and removal of all bags from the skip bins
- All bins with the Emerald Show sign (58) to be lined up next to the Plants and Flower shed
- All bins with JJ's Waste sign (100) to be lined up on the grass opposite the show office
- The showgrounds needs to be clean of all rubbish ready for it to be handed back to council Monday Morning

## **Extra information**

- A number of vehicles and trailers will be required to carry out this tender's requirements or a large group that can cover multiple areas.
- Rubbish bins and skips are provided.
- Gloves, rubbish nippers and bin bags are supplied by the Emerald Show Society
- Skip bins are located behind the bar, guild camping area and rodeo grounds. Majority of skips are set up in the rodeo grounds. Any full skips in the rodeo grounds and guild area are scheduled to be replaced on Thursday by JJ's Waste. If skips become full please contact the show society representative assigned to your tender as soon as possible. Final skip bin collection is Monday 10th June 2025.
- No vehicle movement is permitted in public access area after 8am on Tuesday and Wednesday.
- All volunteers need to be inducted in the process and their workplace prior to commencing work, we would suggest that.
- If children are undertaking this tender they must be supervised at all times.
- There will need to be one contact person who is in charge of this tender and all the operations during the event.
- The safety of our patrons and volunteers is very important if there is a safety risk that arises please notify the Show Society representative as soon as possible.
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- Volunteer lanyards will be provided for access through the gate. These are not to be used as entry into the show once the shift has been completed. Tickets can be purchased online or at the gate.
