INFORMATION

- There will need to be one contact person who is in charge of this tender and all the
 operations during the event. This person will communicate with the show society before, during
 and after the event.
- Volunteers must check patron have a 18+ armband on and if they don't check ID and place the armband on their wrist before taking payment for drink tickets.
- Security will man the entries and check ID and place 18+ arm bands on patrons at peak time.
- Show Society Stubby Coolers to be sold with drink tickets.
- Drink tickets will be kept by Bar staff and rotated back to drink ticket sales for re sale.
- 4 volunteer lanyards will be allocated for volunteers to gain entry into the showgrounds to
 work their shift. The lanyards must be worn by volunteers at all times. Once the shift is over you
 are to hand your volunteer lanyard to the next person on shift or place back in the provided
 ticket sales box. The volunteer lanyards are to gain you entry through the gate to attend your
 designated shift, not to give you entry into the show. Individual tickers must be purchased
 online or at the gate.
- Procedures regarding square machines and floats will be provided to the contact person
 prior to the show, a meeting will be arranged for the nominated contact person to meet our
 committee and discuss further details regarding the overall operations of the drink ticket sales
 if required.
- All volunteers need to be inducted in the process and their workplace prior to commencing work, we would suggest that all volunteers arrive on site 15min before their rostered shift starts.
- Drink ticket sale staff DO NOT need to hold an RSA.
